Dear Exhibitors,

It is once again time to invite you to the Auburn University Block and Bridle Club Sheep and Goat Show. This year's show will be held on August 22, the fourth Saturday in the month. We are happy to announce that we will once again be hosting the show at the Stan Wilson Beef Teaching Unit, located at 500 Shug Jordan Parkway. Check-in/weigh-in will begin at 8:00 am and end at 10:00 a.m. The show will start at 11:00 a.m. The 2009 show will consist of showmanship, breeding classes, prospect and market classes for both sheep and goats. USDA premise ID is required to participate.

Last year was the first time in several years that the B&B Lamb and Goat Show had not been held on the third Saturday of August but due to last year's great turnout and Auburn University classes starting late again this year we have decided once again to hold it a week later on the calendar. This event is a great and valuable experience not only for you, the exhibitor, but also for the members of Block & Bridle who gain hands-on experience working with the lambs, and goats as well as the exhibitors. We hope that having the show the fourth week of the month again will cause no conflicts for you or your family. The show will once again be open to FFA and 4-H members only. Exhibitors must be 9 years old by January 1, 2010 to be eligible to show. All exhibitors must have been born in calendar year 2000 or earlier.

Since we will be holding the show at the Beef Unit we will once again have available wash-racks however, electricity will be limited. Pens and shade will also be available on a first come, first served basis. Club members will be available to assist with directions, check-in, and any questions that may arise.

This year we will also be serving lunch for an additional \$5 per person you can send your money with your registration and let us know how many people to expect with your party.

Entry forms must be postmarked by Monday, August 17. Late entries will be charged double the stated amount. If there are any changes or added details we will be sure to notify you.
